ORDINANCE #26-13 - AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF RIVER EDGE, CHAPTER 192, "DRUG-FREE ZONES" was introduced and passed at a regular meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of River Edge, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, held on Thursday, August 13, 2026, and will be further considered for final passage after public hearing at a regular meeting of the Mayor and Council Thursday, September 10, 2026, at 7:00 P.M. prevailing time, or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard.
