ORDINANCE NO. 26-14 - AN ORDINANCE BY THE MAYOR & COUNCIL AMENDING THE BOROUGH OF RIVER EDGE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO REPEAL CHAPTER 216 FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION; TO ADOPT A NEW CHAPTER 216 FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT REGULATIONS; TO ADOPT FLOOD HAZARD MAPS; TO DESIGNATE A FLOODPLAIN ADMINISTRATOR; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE was introduced and passed at a regular meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of River Edge, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, held on Thursday, September 10, 2026, and will be further considered for final passage after public hearing at a regular meeting of the Mayor and Council Thursday, September 24, 2026, at 7:00 P.M. prevailing time, or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard.

The meetings of the River Edge Mayor and Council are held in person in Council Chambers located at 705 Kinderkamack Road as well as via Zoom. Members of the public who wish to participate may secure access information as shown on the Borough's website www.riveredgenj.org.

A clear and concise statement of this ordinance is to adopt the NJ Department of Environmental Protection's model ordinance to comply with its NJPACT Resilient Environments and Landscapes (REAL) rules as set forth in the ordinance.
